Day 1 October 25 Australia – Doha

Depart Australian cities on Qatar Airways. O/n Inflight

Day 2 October 26

Arrive in Doha where the rest of day is at leisure. O/n Doha

Day 3 October 27 Doha – Madrid

Morning departure from Doha and arrive in Madrid early afternoon, where the afternoon is at leisure. Tonight, we meet our Tour Director and fellow travellers. (D)

Day 4 October 28 Madrid

Today we enjoy an included guided sightseeing tour. A full panoramic drive by way of the Avenida Mayor, Puerta del Sol, Parliament Square, and a picture stop outside the Royal Palace. The optional trip to Toledo is most rewarding, too. The splendid setting of this old walled city above the Tagus was made famous in El Greco's painting, and even now it's like a great open-air museum of Spanish history and art. (B)

Day 5 October 29 Madrid – Avila – Salamanca – Coimbra

Visit ancient fortified Avila with its many towers, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Continue to Salamanca and make sure you spend some time wandering around Plaza Mayor the grandest square in Spain. Cross the frontier to Guarda, the highest town in Portugal. From here, descend to the valleys of the Serra da Estrela to Coimbra. (B,D)

Day 6 October 30 Coimbra – Fatima – Obidos - Lisbon

Enjoy an orientation tour of Coimbra, celebrated for its beauty and ancient university. Later, travel southwards to visit the Sanctuary of Fatima, one of Europe's most celebrated Marian shrines. Continue to fortified Obidos, one of the most picturesque towns in Portugal, before reaching Lisbon for two overnight stays. (B)

Day 7 November 1 Lisbon

Henry the Navigator made Lisbon the 15th-century "Mistress of the Seas." On the included guided tour, see his monument, the Belem Tower, the Moorish Citadel, and the impressive Black Horse Square. Spend the afternoon at leisure- maybe in the Alfama's tile-decorated streets, or take an optional excursion to coastal Estoril and Cascais. (B)

Day 8 November 2 Lisbon – Seville

From the rolling plains of the Alentejo with its woodlands of cork and eucalyptus trees, head southwards all the way to the brilliant light of Andalusia. Admire its neat, white-painted villages and sun-drenched plantations of olives, figs, and almonds while travelling towards magnificent Seville. (B,D)

Day 9 November 3 Seville

Enjoy an included sightseeing tour of the city's main highlights, such as the cathedral, Alcazar, and Plaza d'España. Afternoon at leisure. (B)

Day 10 November 4 Seville – Ferry to Morocco - Rabat

Drive through Spain's pretty sherry wine region and head south to the coast. Here, you will embark the ferry and cruise across the Strait of Gibraltar to Morocco on the African continent. Travel along what was once the infamous Barbary Coast; we then continue the drive south to Rabat, one of Morocco's imperial cities. (B,D)

Day 11 November 5 Rabat – Casablanca - Marrakesh

Today starts with an included guided city sightseeing tour of the country's lively capital, including a visit to Chellah Gardens and Casbah Des Ouaias. Later, reach Morocco's

westernmost city: Casablanca. Enjoy an orientation drive in this modern city and see the illustrious Hassan II Mosque-perched dramatically on a platform over the Atlantic Ocean. One of the largest mosques in the world, its minaret soars 210 metres into the sky and part of the mosque's floor is made of glass so worshippers can kneel directly over the ocean's waters. Continue on to the "red" oasis city of Marrakesh. (B,D)

Day 12 November 6 Marrakesh

This morning included city sightseeing that will make you feel like you've been whisked back in time. Founded in the 9th century, Marrakesh remains a tapestry of ramparts, mosques, palaces, gardens, and vibrant public squares and souks (markets)-where buying and selling and a carnival of entertainment and fascinations occur daily. An optional excursion this evening is the perfect end to the day. (B)

Day 13 November 7 Marrakesh – Fez

Today, travel through the fragrant cedar forests of the Middle Atlas mountains, where a number of peaks soar above 3,962 metres in elevation. This range is home to the endangered Barbary ape, as well as wild boar and polecats. On your way north to Fez, enjoy glimpses of North African village life reminiscent of Beau Geste. (B,D)

Day 14 November 8 Fez

Ancient Fez is a city of outstanding scenic beauty. Visit the Medina during included sightseeing this morning, and enjoy the maze of narrow streets through the colourful bazaars and exotic atmosphere. The madrasas, fondouks, palaces, residences, mosques, and fountains dating back to the 13th century are now UNESCO World Heritage Sites. In the afternoon, explore further on your own. (B)

Day 15 November 9 Fez – Ferry Crossing to Spain – Costa Del Sol

Today, an early departure takes you north for the Ferry back to mainland Spain to the Costa del Sol (Coast of the Sun) (B,D)

Day 16 November 10 Costa Del Sol – Granada

Drive along the Costa del Sol and head to Granada in the heart of Andalusia. On the agenda: an included guided visit of the Alhambra Complex, a lavish palace and fortress built by Moorish kings. With construction dating back to 889 AD, you'll marvel at its architectural Moorish beauty and magnificent gardens. Enjoy free time to explore Granada at leisure. (B,D)

Day 17 November 11 Granada – Madrid

Travel through the very heart of Don Quixote's La Mancha, famed for its castle and windmills. Before arriving in Madrid, visit a local wine cellar and taste some of the locally produced wines. (B)

Day 18 November 12 Madrid

This is the official end of the tour and we have an additional day at leisure. O/n Madrid

Day 19 November 13 Madrid – Inflight

Another day at leisure. Early evening airport transfer for our evening flight to Doha. O/n Inflight

Day 20 November 14 Doha - Inflight

Arrive in Doha in the morning and later connect with an Australian bound flight. O/n Inflight
